

# Job Description

The position is currently 100% telework, but travel to Washington, DC several times a week will be required in the future. Applicants selected will be subject to a security investigation and may need to meet eligibility requirements for access to classified information. The successful candidate will provide an objective view of justice-related performance management systems and processes and help lead efforts to create programs that are results focused. This person will:

- Serve as subject matter expert on performance management, data-driven decision-making, performance measures, program design, and evidence-based practices
- Assist with performance measures development or revisions (e.g., attend meetings, review drafts)
- Provide subject matter expertise on reports and other deliverables
- Serve as the lead/co-lead for certain assigned task areas
- Respond to ad hoc data analysis requests that may have quick turnaround times
- Develop professional quality written documents (i.e., reports, summaries, fact sheets), PowerPoint presentations, and emails to communicate analysis results
- Assist in defining and reporting program results by consulting with stakeholders to identify key metrics; develop various deliverables based on those metrics (e.g., report, dashboards)
- Provide technical assistance to federal staff on performance measures, performance management, program design, and data collection and reporting (i.e., through logic modeling process)
- Facilitate meetings and discussions with federal staff and internal team members, including the development of agendas, meeting materials, and follow-up communication
- Clean and organize datasets for analysis
- Design and implement assigned project deliverables from start to finish
- Develop and manage project deliverable timelines and schedules, including management of team member contributions
- Review and provide feedback to team members on deliverables

- 5 years of experience with analysis of quantitative and qualitative data and performance measurement (a significant portion must be in the justice area)

- Ability to perform assigned tasks with minimal to no supervision

- Experience with data analysis and data presentation and knowledge of statistical software packages (SPSS, STATA, SAS, R) and data visualization software such as Tableau or Socrata
- Strong written, editing, and verbal communication skills including the ability to communicate technical data to non-technical audiences
- An analytic, detail-oriented approach and an ability to work with medium-sized data sets
- Ability to manage multiple tasks and tight deadlines simultaneously
